
DATA COLLECTION POLICY ARMATURA SZCZAWIŃSKI WITH REGISTERED OFFICE IN ŁÓDŹ

This Policy applies to "cookies" files and applies to websites operated by ARMATURA SZCZAWIŃSKI MICHAŁ SZCZAWIŃSKI based in Łódź, ul. Solec 24/26, 94-247, Łódź, with REGON: 526060489 and NIP: 727-269-51-49. (hereinafter: "ARMATURA SZCZAWIŃSKI").

1. Cookies.

A cookie is a small text file sent by a website after visiting the website address in the browser. Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, that are saved on the end device (computer, laptop, smartphone) used to browse the Website by a person entering the website address in the browser (hereinafter: "User"). Cookies contain information necessary for the proper functioning of the Websites and enable remembering the User's preferences, personalizing the Websites in terms of displayed content and matching advertisements. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, their storage time on the end device and a unique number. The information contained in cookies allows reading the information contained therein only by the website through interaction with which they were created. The entity that places cookies on the website User's end device and obtains access to them is Armatura Szczawiński

2. Types of cookies

used by Armatura Szczawiński Armatura Szczawiński uses two types of cookies on its websites:

- "session cookies" - temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until they leave the Website or turn off the software (web browser);
- "persistent cookies" - "permanent" files that are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User. This type of file allows information to be transferred to the server every time a website is visited.

Armatura Szczawiński informs that websites do not automatically collect any information about Users, except for information contained in cookies.

3. Purpose of using cookies.

Cookies are used on websites to measure User activity and adjust the website content to the User's individual preferences by identifying the end device in order to correctly display the website content. Armatura Szczawiński also uses cookies to customize and improve the way websites work, as well as to measure the effectiveness of the actions carried out. Cookies also

enable Armatura Szczawiński to examine User preferences and thus constantly improve the quality of the services provided. Websites may use cookies that perform the following functions:

- cookies enabling the use of services available on the Websites, e.g. cookies used for services requiring User authentication;
- cookies used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect authentication abuses on the Websites;
- cookies enabling the collection of information on how the Websites are used;
- cookies, enabling automatic application of settings selected by the User and personalization of the User's interface (e.g. in terms of the selected language or region from which the User comes, font size, appearance of the website, etc.) when next using the Website;
- cookies that enable the provision of advertising content to Users more tailored to their interests. Armatura informs that cookies will not be used to contact the User via telephone, e-mail or traditional mail.

4. External websites.

External websites to which the website may refer may also use cookies other than those listed above, including in particular files enabling logging in and delivering advertisements corresponding to the User's preferences and behavior, for example - on YouTube.com - documenting preferences and the number of User clicks (YouTube.com's privacy policy is available at the following address: <http://www.google.pl/intl/pl/policies/privacy/>)

5. User's consent to the use of cookies.

Armatura Szczawiński informs that the software used to browse websites (web browser, e.g. Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, etc.) allows cookies to be stored on the User's end device by default. Users of the Website may change cookie settings at any time by changing the web browser settings on the end device. These settings can be changed, in particular, in a way that allows blocking the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or informing each time they are placed on the User's end device. Detailed information about the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the software settings of the web browser used by the User. Cookies placed on the User's end device may also be used by contractors cooperating with Armatura Szczawiński.
